Reporting to the Associate Dean for Academic Affairs, the director responsible for leading the collaborative development and implementation of a comprehensive and integrated assessment system regarding student-learning outcomes. The incumbent is also responsible for the coordination and implementation of Curry-wide and disciplinary accreditation processes.

A master's degree with a specialization in education assessment, measurement, program evaluation or a related field is required. A doctoral degree is preferred. At least four years of relevant professional experience in program assessment and accreditation management, with at least one year of educational assessment experience is required. Outstanding problem solving and creative thinking skills, as well as exceptional interpersonal, verbal and written communication abilities are a must. Strong organizational and project management skills are essential. Working knowledge of program assessment processes and accreditation standards in education (e.g., SACSCOC, CAEP, APA, CACREP, ASHA, CAATE) is also required. Must be proficient in use of Excel, Access and/or statistical and qualitative analysis programs for reporting and decision support.
