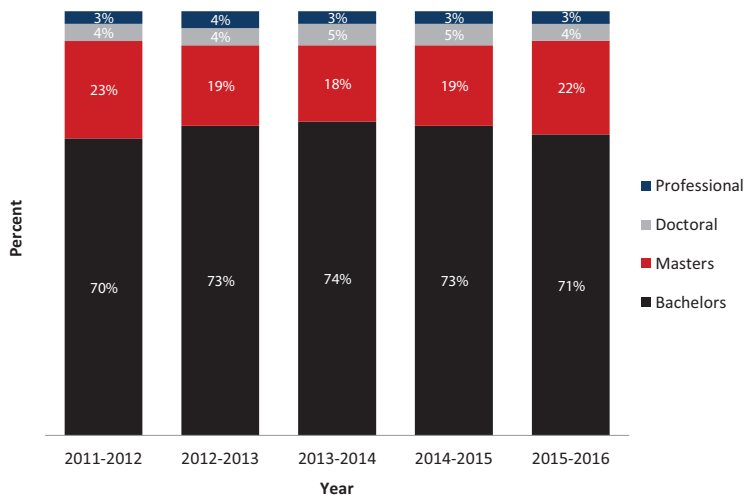

FY 2012 - FY 2016 Degrees Conferred



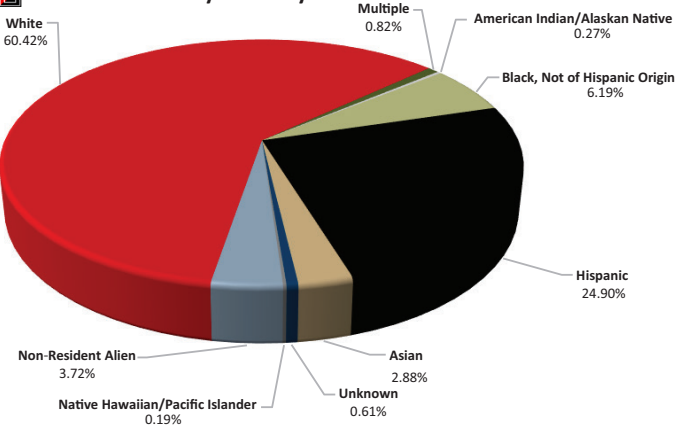

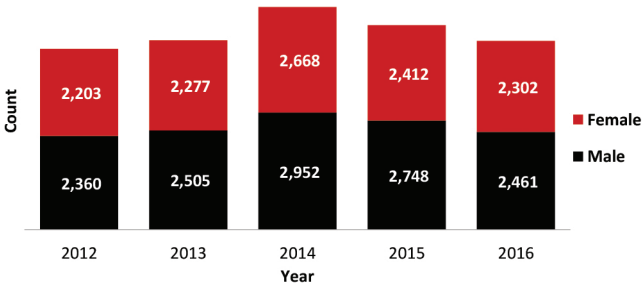

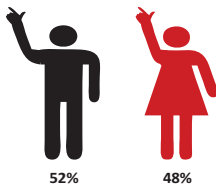

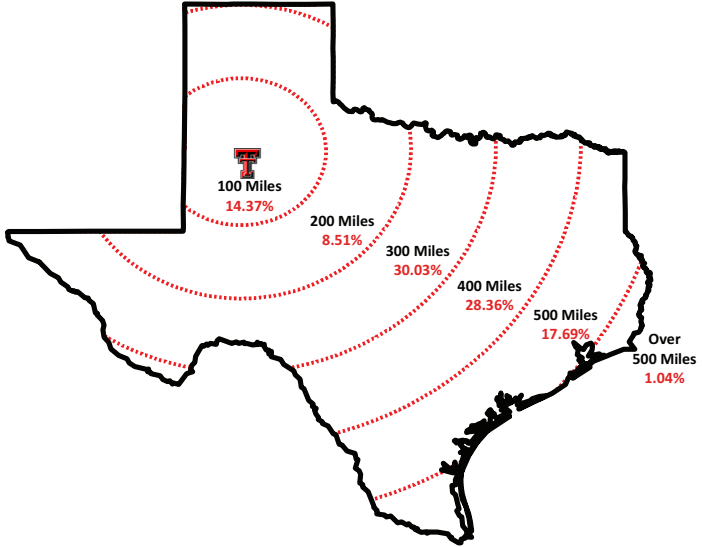

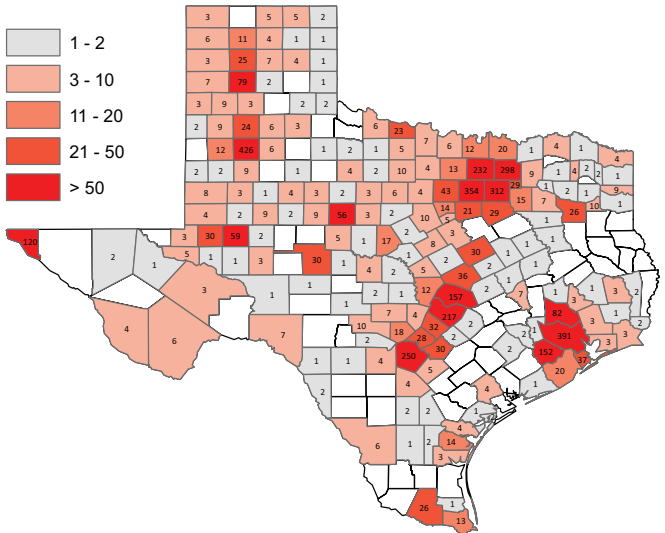

Distribution of New Freshmen from Texas by County

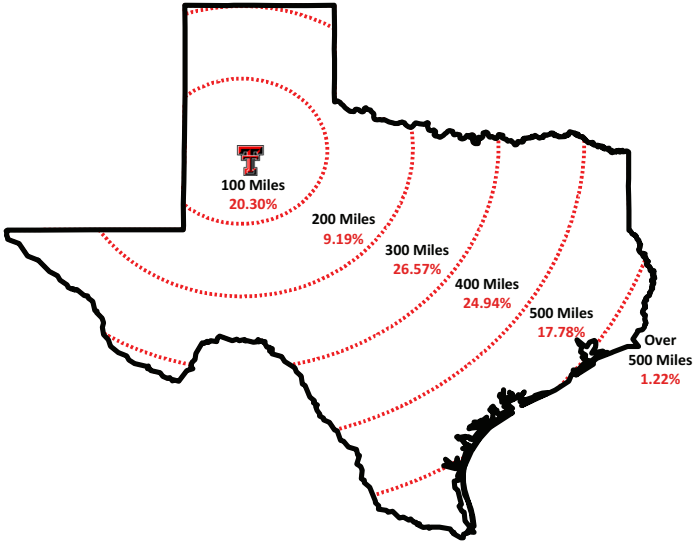

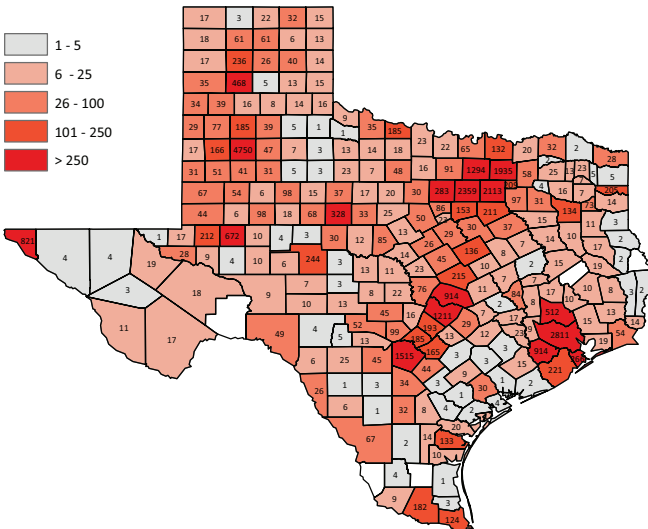

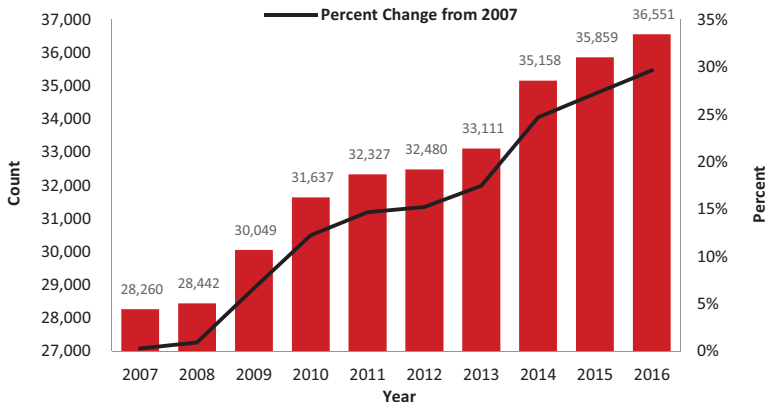

Distribution of Total Enrollment from Texas by County

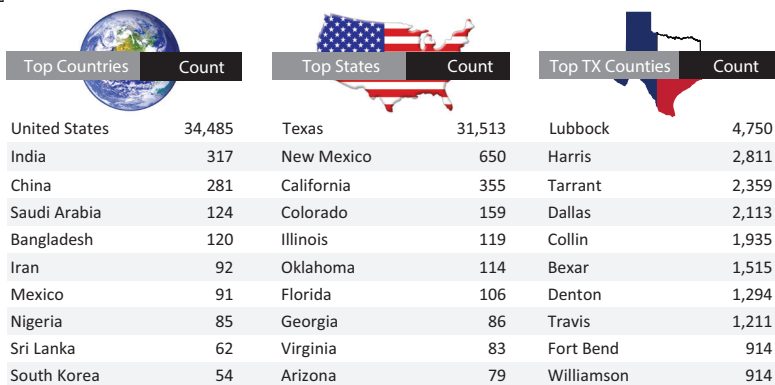




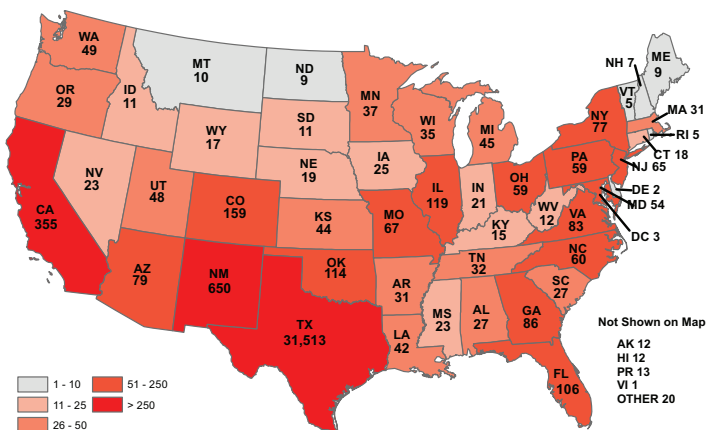
Fall 2016 Total Enrollment Over 10 Years



Fall 2016 Total Enrollment by Geographic Origin



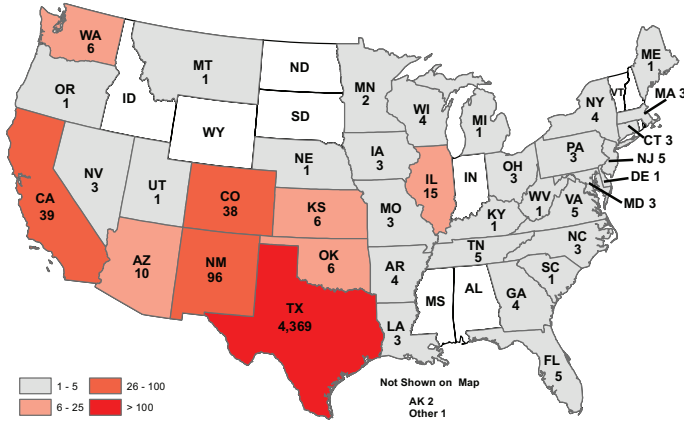
Fall 2016 Distribution of Total Enrollment by State

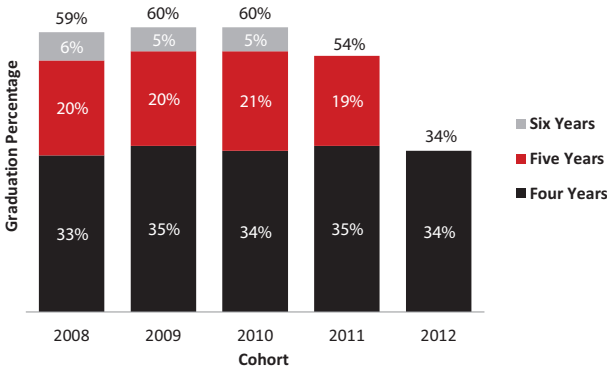

2016 Six-Year Graduation Rate for Full-Time, Degree-Seeking New Freshmen

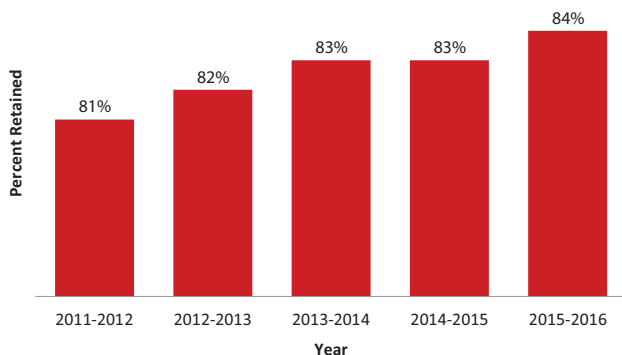

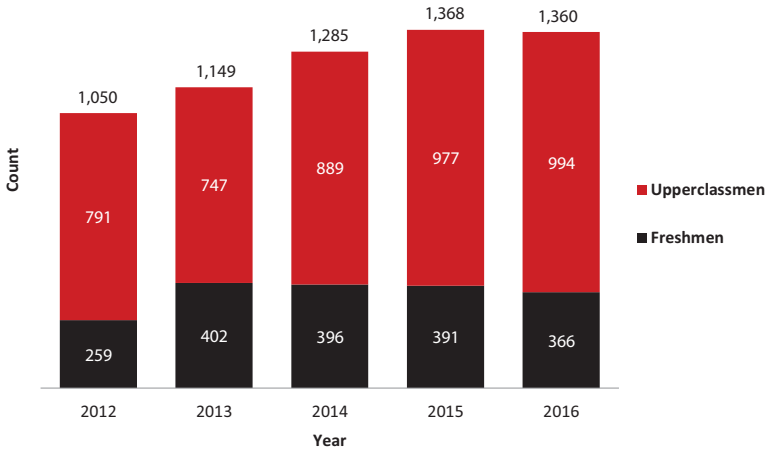

Financial Aid

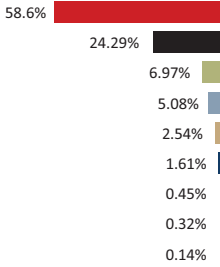
- Over 79% of TTU students receive some type of financial aid including scholarships, grants, work study, and loans.

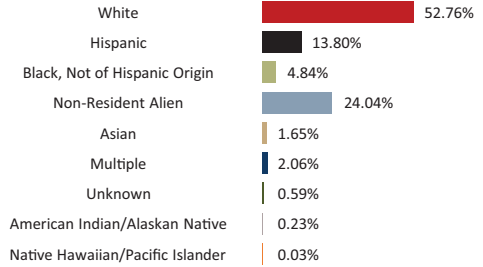

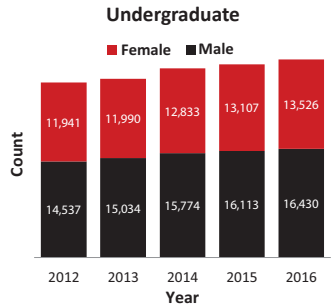

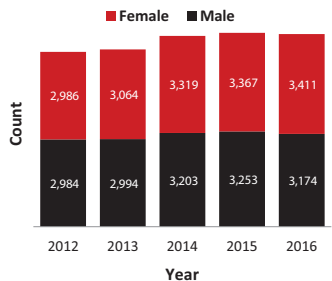

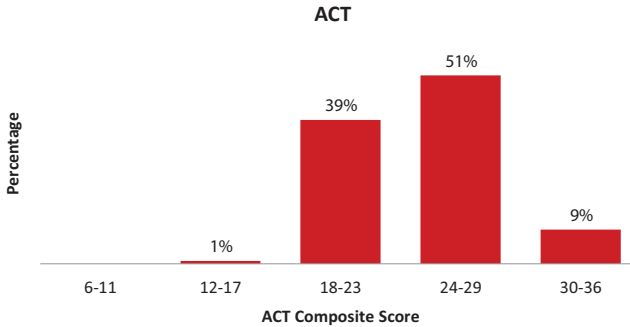
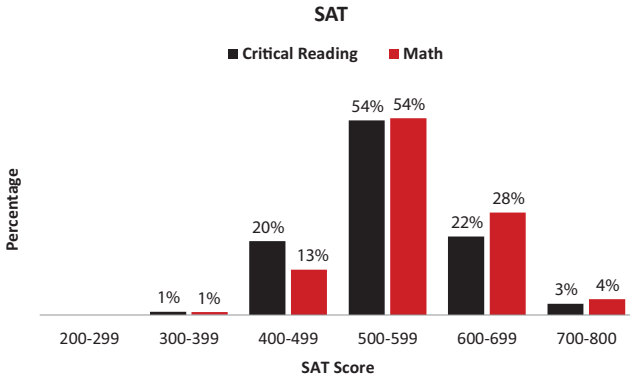

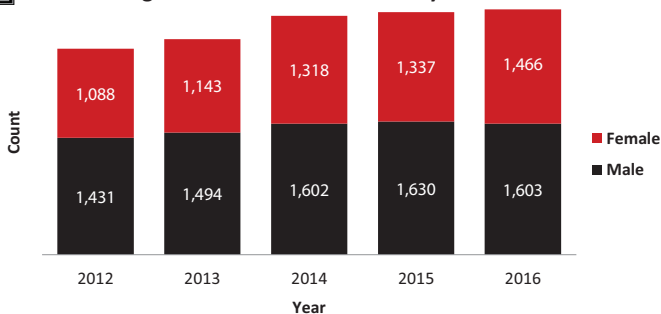

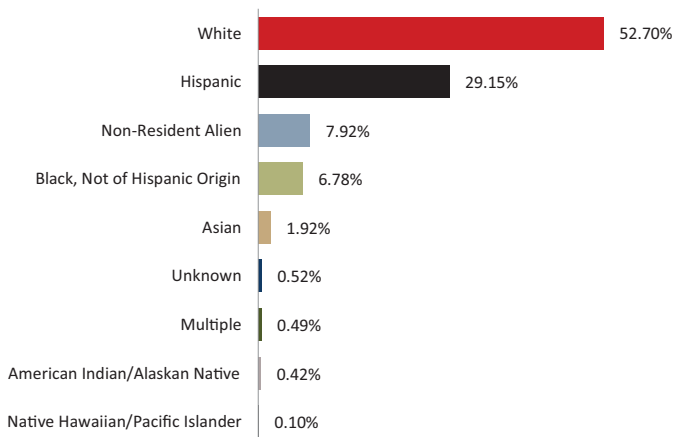
