


President's Message - Julie Fulghum, 2018-19

She will also receive a plaque in honor of this achievement at the SAIR Conference in Greenville, SC in September 2019. The Best Paper Award Committee included Susannah Livingood (University of Oklahoma, Chair), Shama Akhtar (Bowie State University), Dr. Eric Lovik (Radford University), and Dr. Suzanne Simpson (University of Alabama in Huntsville). 

The SAIR Board had an opportunity to meet there in February and it is a great venue in downtown Greenville, a town that has been fully transformed into a vibrant, beautiful walkable downtown with loads of dining shopping and entertainment options. Is it okay to say I was surprised? Pleasantly so. The theme for this year's conference is "*Tools for Transformation*" Our planning process has been transformed using project management software and we hope this is the **largest SAIR Annual Conference** in recent memory. 












THE LATEST FROM SAIR AFFILIATES...Updates on 2019 Conferences
